

Call for Papers and Special Sessions

The 13th IEEE Vehicle Power and Propulsion Conference (VPPC) will be organized by Zhejiang University and held in Hangzhou, China on Oct. 17-20, 2016. In order to promote clean technologies for future transportation systems, this conference aims to provide a forum for sharing knowledge, experience and ideas in vehicle power and propulsion. Technical papers, tutorials and industry participations are all welcome. Proposals of special sessions are also gratefully expected.

All presented papers will be included in the conference proceedings and transferred to the database of IEEEExplore and EI Compendex, and can be submitted to the IEEE Transactions on Vehicular Technology for peer review (note, mandatory extension of >50% is required).

Each SS will have about six papers. SS organizers should seek an appropriate number of papers. SS papers will be peer-reviewed as the regular.



Digest Submission Guidelines

A digest of 3-5 pages (including figures, tables and an abstract of 50-100 words) should be submitted in PDF format via the conference website. It should be prepared in English and in the 2-column IEEE format. All submitted digests will be peer reviewed in order to ensure the highest technical quality of the conference.
